WELCOME to the 2023-24 School Year!

Connections Visual and Performing Arts Academy is a fully accredited charter school for students in grades 7-12 focusing on visual and performing arts, integrated with Summerville High School. Connections has been recognized by US News and World Report as a top high school in the United States in 2013, 2014 and 2016.

Connections VPAA opened in 2002, and now has 200 students. Students have the opportunity to work with a choir director, choreographer, and accompanists in the vocal choir program. In theatrical productions, students are coached by directors, vocal directors, and choreographers. Costume and set designers assist in creating professional-quality productions. Students in the ballet/dance program are taught by a professional dance instructor, and both the dance and ballet classes perform in a recital at the end of the year. Band members are in the Orange Crush and the Zero Hibernation Jazz Band. Each year, film and art students screen their work at the Academy Art and Film Festival, and several student films have been screened at independent film festivals.

There are no attendance boundaries for Connections VPAA, so any student who lives in Tuolumne, Calaveras, Mariposa or Stanislaus County is eligible to attend. Students may not have any grades lower than C at the end of their 8th grade year. They must have a record of good attendance and no significant discipline issues. Students out of the district are not required to get an interdistrict transfer for Connections Academy.

Connections VPAA students are able to enroll in all academic, athletic and extracurricular programs available at Summerville High School. The focus on arts programs allows for a large variety of elective classes in the arts for students in both school programs, including piano, guitar, art, photography, drama, film, choir, band and dance.

Graduates from Connections VPAA have attended: The American Musical and Dramatic Academy, Occidental College, Berklee College of Music, Stanford, Notre Dame, UC Berkeley, UC Davis, UC Irvine, UCLA, UC Santa Cruz, UC San Diego, USC, UOP, University of Portland, Western Washington University and many California State Universities. Several graduates have traveled as cast members for the Young Americans. All students enroll in eight classes. Class periods are 90 minutes long, with 4 classes meeting on A days, and 4 classes meeting on alternate B days. School begins at 7:55am and ends at 3:05 pm. The first day of school is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, August 23rd.

ENGLISH:	40
Eight consecutive semesters of English	
SOCIAL STUDIES:	30
Two semesters of World History; two semesters of U.S. History; one semester of U.S. Government; one semester of Econ/Civics.	
MATHEMATICS:	30
Six semesters selected from mathematics course offerings required of all students. All students must complete one year of Algebra or Math I.	
SCIENCE:	20
Four semesters of science required: one year Biology or Life Science, one year Earth/Physical Science.	
PHYSICAL EDUCATION:	30
Students must be enrolled for each of the first six semesters of high school. Six semesters must be passed.	
FINE ARTS/FOREIGN LANGUAGE:	10
Students must pass one year of a foreign language, art, music, film or drama. Students may substitute one year of vocational education courses for graduation requirements.	
NON-DEPARTMENTAL:	20
One semester of Health and one semester of Keyboarding/Careers during the freshman year and two semesters of Senior Seminar in the senior year.	
OTHER COURSES:	120
As indicated by major course of study and student's life plan.

Students interested in applying to a UC campus need to complete the 15 A-G requirements, with at least 11 finished prior to the beginning of their senior year, with no grade lower than a C, and at least a 3.0 GPA in these courses. Students may apply to UC campuses between November 1 and November 30 of their senior year.

CSU Admission Information: www.calstate.edu

Students interested in applying to a CSU campus need to complete the A-G requirements with no grade lower than a C. Students need to complete the SAT reasoning test or ACT no later than December of their senior year. Some campuses, such as Cal Poly, recommend students take the SAT or ACT no later than November of their senior year. Students may apply to CSU campuses between October 1 and November 30 of their senior year.

NCAA Eligibility Center

If you want to compete in NCAA sports, you need to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center. Plan to register before starting your freshman year of high school (or year nine of secondary school). Visit NCAA.org for more information on how to get started.

**CONNECTIONS VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS ACADEMY
ACADEMIC AGREEMENT**

It is the philosophy of Connections Visual and Performing Arts Academy to provide a balanced, rich, strong artistic and academic environment. Students who attend the academy must show an interest in being involved in our arts curriculum, and understand the parameters as set forth in this agreement between the school and the student with his or her parents.

1. Students must maintain grades of "C" or above in all of their coursework.
2. Students must maintain at least 90% attendance.
3. Students will be placed on academic probation should one or more of their grades fall below a C for the semester or their attendance drop below 90%. They will have one semester to show improvement or risk being removed from the Academy.
4. If it becomes clear that the student is not completing assignments, or not demonstrating effort in class, they may also be removed. This would not take place until after a parent conference is held.
5. Students must maintain good behavior and follow the district's discipline guidelines. If a student at the Academy is determined to have violated a policy that results in suspension, or have repeated discipline consequences, they may be removed from the Academy.
6. Cell phone use- Cell phones are prohibited during class time.
7. Students will participate in all standardized tests (Smarter Balanced, etc.)
8. Parents are encouraged to follow their child's progress by using the District's "Powerschool" program linked to our school website. They are also encouraged to become an active participant in their child's education by communicating with teachers and the principal when needed.
9. Parents are also encouraged to attend Connections Advisory Board meetings to give input on activities and curriculum related to the program, and/or participate in C.A.S.T., the Creative Arts Support Team.
