



Mask Medical Exemption (Student)

California Department of Public Health currently requires masks indoors in K-12 schools, childcare, and other youth settings.

All students are required to wear a mask that covers the nose, mouth, and chin while they are on campus. A face covering is defined as a surgical mask, a medical procedure mask, a respirator worn voluntarily, or fabric with at least 2 layers. Exemptions or alternatives may be considered for people with a documented medical condition, mental health, or disability that prevents wearing a mask as well as persons who are hearing impaired. It is your responsibility to provide the appropriate documentation from your medical provider; must be made by a physician, nurse practitioner, or other licensed medical professional practicing under the license of a physician.
