# Summerville Union High School District Stadium and Softball Facility Use Agreement

These requirements are in place for all school and non-school activities taking place in these facilities.

Please observe the following rules.

- No chewing gum, food, candy, sunflower seeds, nuts, glass, fireworks, stakes, sharp objects, or spitting are allowed on the track or turf.
- No sports drinks, soda, coffee or beverages other than water are allowed on the track surface or turf.
- No glass containers or sunflower seeds are allowed inside the facilities.
- No dogs or other pets.
- Tobacco use and smoking are prohibited on school grounds.
- Alcoholic beverages, use of drugs, intoxicants or possession of a weapon on a school site are prohibited by law.
- No bicycles, skateboards, strollers, chairs, benches, rollerblades, or other equipment are permitted on the track or on the turf, with the exception for equipment approved for use in school-related activities.
- No golfing or shot put allowed on Thorsted Field or the all-weather track.
- Only the appropriate footwear as per each sport is allowed on the synthetic surface.
- Do not track dirt or mud onto the turf field or track.
- Please pick up and dispose of all litter.
- All bodily fluid spills on the turf must be treated following blood-borne pathogen guidelines.
- Spectators are not allowed on the fields before, during, or after contests.
- Athletes and coaches entering and exiting Thorsted Field may walk across the track only on temporary mats placed for that purpose.

# General considerations and requirements:

- Vehicles are prohibited on District synthetic surfaces with the exception of those vehicles used in the care and maintenance of the turf field and vehicles approved for use in school-related activities.
- Ambulance or EMT may park in designated area near the gate. In case of emergency, injured participants will be wheeled off the field on a gurney to the closest access to the all synthetic surface, and wheeled to the vehicle for transport. Vehicles equipped for public roads are not allowed on the synthetic surfaces at any time.
- Fireworks inside the stadium are strictly prohibited.
- Any movement of equipment on synthetic surfaces shall be done with wheeled trailers or wagons intended for use on this surface. No equipment shall be dragged or dropped onto any of the all-weather field surfaces.

- For events on Thorsted Field, the public is not allowed during any event to be outside of the fenced and railed areas such as on the hillside or behind the bleachers.
- For events on Thorsted Field and renting the Snack Shack and/or Press Box, an organization representative shall be trained in the correct use of each before gaining access.
- Any deposit shall be returned following an inspection by District personnel following the event, less the cost of any damages.
- Public use is until dusk, when school or public events are not in session. The public is asked to follow facility use rules when using the track for exercise and to restrict use to the following:
  - Lanes 1 and 2 are closed
  - o Lanes 3, 4, and 5 are to be used by runners.
  - Lanes 6 and 7 used by walkers.
