Apple Summer App Camp

In this 3-week hands-on camp, students will learn to build mobile apps using Apple software and hardware tools. Each day will be divided into a morning session, lunch, and then an afternoon session. In the morning session, leveraging Apple's Swift Playground environment, students will learn the fundamentals of programming (commands, loops, logical operators, variables, arrays, functions, etc). In the afternoon session, students will leverage their newfound programming skills alongside Apple's creative tools (GarageBand, Clips, and IMovie) and the code.org app lab environment to build their own multi-media apps and games. There is no cost to attend the camp. No experience is necessary; everybody is welcome.

Summerville advances to D6 softball championship with upset win over No. 1 seed Millennium.

With a 4-2 upset victory Thursday in Tracy over No. 1 seed Millennium High School, the Summerville Bears are headed to the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section Division VI championship softball game.

It will be the Bears' second championship appearance in school history.

The Bears were led Thursday by senior pitcher Madi Cribbs, whose phenomenal outing on the mound kept Summerville in the driver's seat all game long.

Cribbs was dealing, ending the night with a remarkable 20 strikeouts in 27 batters faced. She allowed only one hit, with three walks.

The Bears will travel to Cosumnes River College to take on the No. 2 Riverbank Bruins in the section championship game at 1:30 p.m. Saturday.

We will be doing on campus sports physicals for next year's athletic seasons for our students on May 25th at 6:30pm-8:30pm in the gyms. The cost is \$20 per physical.
