How to get to your Google Classrooms



- Google Classrooms
 - 1. Click on the Google Classroom Icon that is on your iPad.
 - 2. Click the small + on the top right of the screen to join a class for the first time
 - 3. Type in the teacher's class code. This can be found on the teacher's syllabus or the Google Classroom Code Spreadsheet.
 - 4. Click "join" and you're in
 - Once established, just click on the Google Classroom icon and select the class you wish to access.
 - If you need help, contact your teacher via email or phone.
