Choice of insurance payment methods

The cost to insure a device is \$25 per student. Insurance covers theft, loss, and accidental damage to the device. Parents will be responsible for the replacement cost of damaged or lost devices if insurance is not purchased (\$300/iPad - \$350/Chromebook), or damage is done intentionally to the device.

♦ Mobile Device Management system

All student devices are managed using a Mobile Device Management (MDM) system. Devices are pre-configured for student use which utilizes the following features:

- □ Provides secure access to Email and Wi-Fi networks, and filters all usage on and off-campus.
- □ Keeps devices up-to-date, and protects against inappropriate and unnecessary apps. Only pre-approved apps are loaded onto devices by school administrators.
- □ Allows school administration to remotely "wipe" or turn off certain apps or features on mobile devices.
