Algebra 2/Math III); 4 years recommended

D. Laboratory Science 2 years, one of Biology and one of Physical Earth.

3 years recommended

E. Foreign Language 2 years of same language required; 3 years

recommended

F. Visual or Performing Arts 1 year of same subject

G. College Preparatory Electives 1 year coursework in addition to minimum

requirements in subjects listed above

UC Admission Information: www.universityofcalifornia.edu/admissions

Students interested in applying to a UC campus need to complete the 15 A-G requirements, with at least 11 finished prior to the beginning of their senior year, with no grade lower than a C, and at least a 3.0 GPA in these courses. Students may apply to UC campuses between November 1 and November 30 of their senior year.

CSU Admission Information: www.calstate.edu

Students interested in applying to a CSU campus need to complete the A-G requirements with no grade lower than a C. Students need to complete the SAT reasoning test or ACT no later than December of their senior year. Some campuses, such as Cal Poly, recommend students take the SAT or ACT no later than November of their senior year. Students may apply to CSU campuses between October 1 and November 30 of their senior year.

NCAA Eligibility Center

If you want to compete in NCAA sports, you need to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center. Plan to register before starting your freshman year of high school (or year nine of secondary school). Visit NCAA.org for more information on how to get started.

All student-athletes must have a <u>parent/guardian</u> register them for each sport they are interested in participating in, through our on-line process. The online registration process will be available starting May 1st 2023. Just go to our school web site (<u>www.summbears.net</u>) and click on the Athletic Tab. This will take you to our Athletic web page. Once there, click the "Registration" Tab, open or set up your family account and easily progress through the steps needed to register. (If you need more help, refer to the on-line registration instructions on our web page under "ANNOUNCEMENTS") You must register your student for each sport separately but, once your student is registered for one sport, the information is saved. To add an additional sport, click on BEGIN REGISTRATION again. Also available online is the 2023-2024 Student-Athlete/Parent Handbooks, transportation forms, schedules, pictures, important links and more.
