Summer School:

Summer school dates: Session #1 June 14-July 1. Session #2 July 6- July 22. There are still plenty of spots available, please contact your student's GLC to enroll.

Masking Requirement:

Based on the most recent information from the state of California including CDPH, Cal/OSHA and Tuolumne County Public Health, masks are required to be worn when indoors on school K-12 campuses. We know there are varying agencies saying different things about masks, but schools must operate under K-12 school regulations and these require masking while indoors when students and staff are present despite any vaccination status.

Important Reminders:

As always, it is critical that we continue to work as a team on campus and in our community to ensure for the safety of all and to ensure that our campus can remain open and our community is safe.

Athletics:

Coaches are preparing for the 2021-2022 school year. Each athlete must be registered on 8to18, have a current physical dated after May 1, 2021, and a current concussion baseline test.

Athletic Registration for the 2021-2022 school year is open! To register, visit our athletics website: <u>https://summerville.8to18.com/accounts/login</u>. If your athlete plans on participating in multiple sports, please sign them up for all sports at the same time.

- **Physicals:** Adventist Health is unable to do the mass sports physicals this year, but both Forest Road Pediatrics (accepts Medi-Cal) and Foothill Pediatrics are leaving spots open for the athletes to get them done starting May 1st. They will be doing a full wellness exam on them in addition to the sports physical exam form. Athletes can still go to their own provider; you just need to make sure to bring your own forms. Please turn in your physical exam form and health history form to the athletics office.
- **Concussion testing:** All incoming freshmen, soon-to-be juniors, and new students will need a new baseline concussion test. Concussion testing will now be available by appointment only. Please contact our Technology and Media Services Coordinator,

Below are the upcoming scheduled clinics which are being held at the Public Health Department on Cedar Road.
