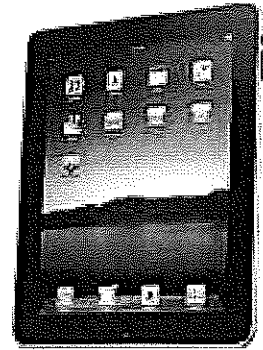


# iPad Information

*All students at Summerville High School and Connections Visual & Performing Arts Academy are issued an iPad for academic courses*



## REQUIRED FOR 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

### ◆ **Incoming 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> Grade & New Students**

**Mandatory Parent/Guardian iPad Information Meeting will be held during Orientation**

- Please bring iPad Use Agreement (enclosed) and insurance payment (information below).
- Parent/guardian meeting attendance during Registration is required for 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade\* and new students to receive an iPad.
- Returning student parents/guardians are not required to attend information meeting.

### ◆ **Choice of insurance payment methods**

The cost to insure an iPad is \$25 per student. Insurance covers theft, loss, and accidental damage to device. Parents will be responsible for replacement cost of damaged or lost iPads if insurance is not purchased (\$400/iPad), or damage is done intentionally to device.

- Credit card payments are accepted online at [schoolpay.com](http://schoolpay.com).
- Check/cash payment accepted at Parent iPad Information Meeting, Registration, or in the Summerville High School District Business Office.

### ◆ **Waived/reduced insurance costs**

Go to <https://secure.ezmealapp.com> to apply online for Free/Reduced-priced meal program.

- Insurance cost is waived for students who qualify for free National Nutrition Program.
- Insurance cost is \$12.50 for students on reduced program.

### ◆ **Mobile Device Management system**

All student iPads are managed using a Mobile Device Management (MDM) system. iPads are pre-configured for student use which utilizes the following features:

- Provides secure access to Email and Wi-Fi networks, and filters all usage on and off-campus.
- Keeps iPads up-to-date, and protects against inappropriate and unnecessary apps. Only pre-approved apps are loaded on to iPads by school administrators.

- Allows school administration to remotely “wipe” or turn off certain apps or features on mobile devices.

## IPad/EQUIPMENT USE AGREEMENT

### SUMMERVILLE UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AGREEMENT FOR USE OF DISTRICT EQUIPMENT

All parties agree with the value assigned to this school district equipment and the assessment of its condition as noted above. Borrower/Student agrees to return the equipment to Summerville Union High School District (District) on or before the return date stipulated above, or upon transfer out of District

Borrower agrees to indemnify Summerville Union High School District from any and all losses, claims, actions, damages, expenses or liabilities including reasonable attorneys' fees, to which District may become subject in connection with borrower's use of equipment or negligence. **Borrower agrees to pay to District any repair costs or the estimated dollar value if the equipment and accessories (power adapter, USB cable) are damaged, lost or destroyed.**

**\*Insurance coverage is available to parents for \$25 to cover the following (iPad only, not accessories):**

- \*Accidental Damage
- \*Fire/Flood Damage
  - includes drops/cracked screens/liquid spills
- \*Vandalism
- \*Liquid Submersion
- \*Natural Disasters
- \*Theft (*police report required*)
- \*Power Surge Due To Lightning

## **STUDENT PLEDGE FOR IPAD USE**

Student agrees to use the iPad issued responsibly for school work and will take good care of it as described in this document.

1. STUDENT will never leave the iPad unattended.
2. STUDENT will never let other individuals use the iPad.
3. STUDENT will know where iPad is at all times.
4. STUDENT will bring a fully-charged iPad to school daily.
5. STUDENT will keep food and beverages away from iPad since they may cause damage.
6. STUDENT will protect the iPad by never removing it from the case provided.
7. STUDENT will not disassemble any part of the iPad or its case, or attempt any repairs.
8. STUDENT will use the iPad and its camera only in ways that are appropriate and educational.
9. STUDENT will not install or remove any apps.
10. STUDENT will not sync the iPad with any computer or iTunes account.
11. STUDENT will not remove or attempt to circumvent the content filtering or management software or, or use a VPN.
12. STUDENT will not place decorations on the iPad or its accessories, and will not deface its serial number or barcode.
13. STUDENT understands that the iPad issued to him/her remains the property of the Summerville Union High School District and is subject to inspection at any time without notice.
14. STUDENT will follow the policies outlined in the schools' iPad Guidelines and Acceptable Use Policy both during school hours and outside the school day.
15. In the case of loss, STUDENT will notify an administrator within 24 hours.
16. In the case of theft, I will notify an administrator within 24 hours and my family is responsible for filing a police report within 72 hours.
17. STUDENT knows that he/she is responsible for loss and all damage caused by neglect or abuse.
18. STUDENT understands that insurance coverage may not apply in the case of intentional abuse.
19. STUDENT agrees to return the iPad and all original accessories (including power adapter, usb cable, and case) in good working condition on the assigned due date.
20. STUDENT understands that social networking is not allowed.
21. STUDENT will not record or photograph anyone without their permission.
22. STUDENT will not distribute inappropriate content, messages, information, pictures or videos.
23. STUDENT understands that when in classroom, "iPads down," means iPads should be placed face down on the desk.

STUDENT and PARENT agrees to the stipulations set forth in the above documents including the iPad Policy, Procedures, and Information; the Acceptable Use Policy for Online Service; Agreement for Use of District Equipment, and the Student Pledge for iPad Use.
