

Metrics for changes to school schedule

Mandatory school closure if 5% (35) of the total population of the school tests positive for COVID 19.

- 14 day full distance learning
- Work with local public health on return plan, apply for state waiver to reopen
- *possible plan = Full distance learning for 2 weeks, hybrid learning for 2 weeks or until voluntary hybrid goals are exceeded, then 12:30 dismissal schedule

Voluntary actions prior to a mandatory closure:

- 14 day voluntary transition to “hybrid learning” when 2.5% of total population (18 of 703) are confirmed with positive COVID-19 tests in a 2 week period.
- 14 day voluntary transition to “hybrid learning” if 5 teachers test positive or must quarantine in a two-week period and the positions cannot be filled by substitutes.
- 14 day voluntary transition to “hybrid learning”, if greater than 50% absent for one week.

School Status Based on CA Tiered Color Codes:

- Purple = 12:30 dismissal schedule
- Red = 12:30 dismissal schedule
- Orange = 12:30 dismissal schedule, add additional minutes to school day (within lunch-time requirements for staff and students)
 - Or remain with 12:30 dismissal if less than 80% attendance
- Yellow = 100% return to full days
 - Or remain with 12:30 dismissal if less than 80% attendance
