Online Registration is coming!

The Summerville Union High School district is excited to announce an online registration/data validation system for the 2019-2020 school year, powered by InfoSnap. This is a secure and green process which allows the district to verify all demographic, emergency, and medical information for your child prior to the start of the 2019-2020 school year. The system will also allow you to electronically sign the annual permission forms and district policies. In short, this process replaces all the hard copy student registration and permission forms that your student receives in the traditional registration packet each summer. When it is time to complete the online forms, you will receive a letter from the Summerville High School District with instructions! If you do not have access to the Internet, you will be able to contact your child's GLC to make an appointment to use a school computer to complete the process.
